3. With joint custody of the children, neither party will pay child support.

Child support is based on guidelines using the parties' gross income. If one spouse makes more than the other, regardless of custody, then that spouse may have to provide support. The children cannot live in a castle with one parent but a hovel with the other. If there is a true joint custodial relationship, the guidelines are adjusted, but there may be an order for support.
