4. The wife always gets to remain in the home until the children graduate from college.

In certain circumstances, a judge may allow the custodial parent (not necessarily the wife), to remain in the home until the children graduate from high school. If your children are older (juniors or seniors in high school), the judge is likely to permit them to remain in the home to finish high school in the same environment. The order will not extend beyond high school, unless the parties mutually agree, because the educational consideration is no longer present.
